

2011 RMHA International Horse Show – Information
September 12-17, 2011 Kentucky Horse Park, Lexington, KY

Arrival Competitors may move in after 12:00 Noon on Sept. 12, 2011 and must be moved out of stalls Sept. 18, 2011 by 10:00 am. For early Arrival information please refer to the Stall Reservation Form.

On Arrival, before you unload, be sure to have Health Certificate* and one copy of negative Coggins test in your hands for inspection by the State Veterinarian or the Barn Manager. If your paperwork is not in order, your horse will not be permitted to unload.

*Out-of-State horses must have a current health certificate issued with-in 10 days of travel, valid for the duration of the competition and travel to and from Lexington, Kentucky. *In-State horses must have a valid 180 day health certificate. Stabling assignments will be posted on the Stabling Chart at the Horse Check-In and on the www.RMHorse.com website prior to arrival.

Traffic and Parking Upon arrival at the KHP follow the signs around the traffic circle and back to the barns, because of the number of participants and the limited area in the barns please plan to unload and proceed immediately to park the trailer in the designated location at the front of the main parking area near the Man of War Polo Field or in the gravel area west of the show office if that area is open.

Farrier Service Farrier Service will be available during the IHS. All Farrier fees must be paid at the time of service.

Vet Service A veterinarian will be on call for emergencies. All Veterinary fees must be paid (directly to the treating vet) at the time of service.

First Aid Emergency Medical Technicians will be on site during hours of show activity. This service is to be used for emergencies only and the EMT personnel will not provide aspirin or Tylenol.

Trade Fair The trade fair will be located in the Covered Arena and will host a variety of vendors selling everything from tack, clothing, artwork and stall signs to embroidered saddle pads.

Food Service The KHP has implemented a full service food service. The concessions at the Indoor arena will be open during the hours of the horse show. Also the restaurant/cafeteria near the KHP Visitors center is open and provides a very nice lunch menu.

Feed and Bedding There is no initial bedding provided. To purchase bedding and or hay you may go to Dever's Trailer and they will handle feed and bedding requests. Hay, straw, feed, shavings and ice will be available for purchase. To order please contact Dever's directly at: 859-233-9702.

Golf Carts Golf Carts are available for rental from Dever's located near the stable area. To order please contact Dever's directly at: 859-233-9702.

Stalls/Barns Please complete the Stalls Reservation for and return to the RMHA Offices with payment to reserve stalls. Stall assignments will be made on a first come first serve basis. Reservations open June 15, 2011.

Barns, individuals are not allowed to attach to barns with nails or screws. Anyone wishing to display banners or curtains must have a structure independent of the barns. Individuals that do not comply will be billed for all damages and repairs.

Parking Passes Seasonal vehicle parking passes/ Trailer Grounds Passes / Golf Cart Licenses may be purchased from the KHP upon arrival. If you bring you own golf cart or work out of your trailer rather than getting a stall
