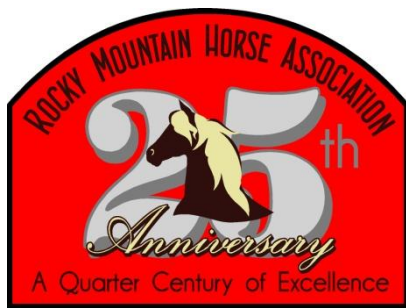




**2011 RMHA 25th Anniversary International
