

## Hearing Complaint Appeal– Robin McVicker

The Rocky Mountain Horse Association had received two complaints against Mr. McVicker in regards to the 2009 RMHA International Show. The complaints state that Mr. McVicker showed a horse named “Champagne on Ice” in class #72, and also showed a horse named “Ref Inferno” in class #67 and that Mr. McVicker was not a member of RMHA nor did he have a valid exhibitor card.

The RMHA records show that Mr. McVicker was not a member and he did not have an exhibitor card. The RMHA records also show that Mr. McVicker used a membership card number of 60683 to register for classes. The RMHA has no record of this membership number.

The SAC evaluated the facts and presented the following recommendations to the RMHA Board of Directors on Saturday, November 14, 2009. The RMHA Board of Directors approved the following SAC recommendation:

1. Robin McVicker is to return all ribbons for classes #67 & #72 and prize money received (\$25.00) for class #72 at the 2009 RMHA International Show.
2. Robin McVicker has no RMHA membership or rights for 2009 and the year beginning January 1, 2010 thru December 31, 2010.
3. A monetary fine of \$250.00.

The RMHA Hearing Panel met on Saturday, January 9, 2010 at the Rocky Mountain Headquarters, 4037 Iron Works Parkway Suite 160, Lexington, Kentucky 40511 regarding an appeal by Mr. McVicker. Based upon information presented to the Hearing Panel, Mr. Mc Vickers’s appeal was denied. As such, the recommendations of the Show Advisory Committee (SAC) and approved by the Board on November 14, 2009 stands:

All fines were due by February 15, 2010, suspensions will continue until all restitution is made.
