**SHOW INFORMATION:**

- \*4 or less entries in a class will start with 2<sup>nd</sup> place paybacks
- Juvenile riders are riders 17 years old and under
- Open / Adult classes are for riders 18 years old and older
- Must compete in one class to compete in a championship class except for Speed Racking Stake class.
- RMHA Sanctioned "A" Show
- Tack changes need to be turned in at time of entry at show office. No tack changes will be awarded at DQP check-in or at the gate unless it is for a break in tack and DQP awards the change.
- ALL winnings will be mailed to exhibitors 7-10 days after date of show
- Horses may wear saddles into DQP inspection area
- 3 minute gate call / 5 minute tack change (2 minutes for tack & 3 minute gate call)

Persons on federal or certified HIO suspensions or disqualifications may not transport a horse to the show grounds and may not participate in the show in any way other than a spectator.

Show Fees: DQP = \$10 per Challenge Cup Horse / \$7 per horse - evening show only  
 Stalls = \$10/wknd-bedding incl. (sawdust) + \$10 per stall cleaning deposit  
 Bedding = \$7 per bag  
 RV = \$ 22 /night (Elec. 30 amp) Bathhouse on Grounds  
 Out of Trailer Fee = \$5 per horse  
**All payments must be cash or check; no Credit Cards can be accepted.**

- Horses may be of any breed. RMHA registered horses must show in a RMHA sanctioned under saddle class
- Horses must be entered in each of the phases of Challenge Cup listed above prior to start of competition.
- The exhibitor must declare one under saddle class prior to start of show. Horse can show multiple times in show portion.
- Points will be awarded for arena trail obstacle and designated under saddle class as follows:  
 1<sup>st</sup> Place = 8 points    2<sup>nd</sup> Place = 7 points    3<sup>rd</sup> Place = 6 points    4<sup>th</sup> Place = 5 points  
 5<sup>th</sup> Place = 4 points    Participation = 3 points

**Trail Course Rules:**

- Each rider will start the course with 80 possible points
- Horses will be inspected prior to leaving on the trail course
- Exhibitors have 2 hours to complete the trail course. No bonus points for completing the course under 2 hours. Time will be recorded and used for tie breakers.
- In case of a tie breaker, time will be used and points will be awarded as for the arena trail obstacle and under saddle class.
- Any rider that completes the course over 2 hours will be penalized 10 points for every 10 minutes over the allotted time.
- Youth (17 & under) shall ride with a “team member” or “companion rider” and must finish with that same rider
- All other exhibitors are encouraged to ride out on the trail course with a “companion rider”, “team member” or fellow competitor.
- Adult exhibitors who started with a “companion rider”, “team member” or fellow competitor, and there are more than 3 to a group, do not have to finish as a group
- While on course, exhibitors will be looking for 4 colorful markers. Once they find those markers, they must pull one numbered ball each and carry that with them to the finish / check-in. Riders must have 4 numbered objects at check-in. Rider will be penalized 5 points per numbered marker they do not have at check-in.
- If a rider realizes before they get to the finish line that they do not have 4 numbered markers, they may turn back around on the course and go find the marker they are missing.
- Horses will be examined by the DQP for any cuts, scrapes, etc. after they cross the finish line at check-in area. If the horse has any cuts or scrapes and those do not cause the horse to not show in the under saddle class, the DQP will record the location of those cuts or scrapes so he has documentation at inspection for the show.
- Riders and horses will not be granted a ticket for such scrapes received on the trail.
- The DQP has the authority to disqualify a horse from further competition if they deem necessary because of lacerations or injury. There will not be an appeal and all decisions are final. Horses will not be ticketed for such disqualification if scratched from further competition.
