*You and your Rocky Mountain Stallion
Are cordially invited to participate in the RMHA Parade of Stallions
Held in the Covered Arena
At 1:30 p.m., Saturday, September 7, 2019
Kentucky Horse Park, Lexington, KY*

Qualifications: The invitation is issued to all RMHA stallions along with their owners, trainers, and exhibitors.

Protocol: Stallions may be shown in hand or under saddle. The horse may be presented by the owner, or another individual if desired. Stallions will enter the ring one at a time passing through the entry gate. Their script will be read as the horse makes one lap around the ring. At the discretion of the handler/rider they may pause and salute the audience or perform a quick maneuver (such as a 360 degree turn, back, bow, etc.) then exit through the exit gate. The script length should be approximately the same length as the exhibition, and no more than 300 words.

Attire: Regardless of whether stallions are led or ridden, it is requested they be presented in top form and groomed to perfection. Semi-formal or show attire is requested for all individuals who are included in the presentation.

Write-Up Required: The Parade of Stallions Information Form must be submitted to the RMHA office (admin@rmhorse.com) by August 26th, 2019. **Do not wait until the day of the parade.** Parade participants will be contacted if an "order of go" is needed (depending on the number of participants).

Thank you in advance for your participation. Spectators will thoroughly enjoy having the opportunity to see your Rocky Mountain Stallion in person.

Please print below or attach additional sheets. Do not use the back of this form. Include the following information in this order if possible (to add consistency for the announcer).

1. Name of the stallion.
2. Name of the presenter at the Stallion Parade as well as the name of the owner,
3. Description – be sure to include anything that is distinctive about your stallion – color, size, awards, where he is standing for breeding, if there is a live foal guarantee, if you ship or freeze semen, etc. Remember, different is better. Spectators will not remember a long list of awards as much as they will remember what makes this horse stand out from the crowd. It is time to shine!
