



COLOR CHANGE REQUEST

NOTE: There may be times when, during certification, a horse’s color is questioned and the owner has not conducted color testing. If the owner conducts a color test at a later date and it proves different from the annotated color on registration/certification paperwork, the owner may request a color change.

RMHA approved colors: Silver Black or Chocolate, Black, Bay or Brown, Silver Bay or Red Chocolate, Buckskin, Palomino, Champagne, Gray, and Gray (Red), Gray (Black), Sorrell, Dun, Red Dun, Grullo (Male), Grulla (Female), Sorrel or Chestnut, Bay Roan, Red Roan, and Black Roan. Owners should note all modifiers such as roaning or silver dapple. A Director of Examiners will sign off on any deviation of these colors and the horse owner will pay for DNA or other genetic testing tools for color.
