

Sara Gwisdalla Versatility Award (12-17 Youth)

The Sara Gwisdalla Youth Versatility Award will be presented to the horse/youth rider (youth aged 12-17) team that achieves the highest total points in 5 of the following classes. Points accumulate only for the specific horse and the specific rider working together. Each team may compete in all 7 classes. **Each team must * compete in and complete the Youth Trail Obstacle class without being disqualified.** Only the team's top 5 scores will be counted using a 10 point scale. In the event of a tie, the team with the highest score in the Youth Trail Obstacle class will be the winner.

The Ashley Hytry Youth Versatility Award will be presented to the horse/youth rider (youth aged 11 and under) team that achieves the highest total points in 4 out of the 7 classes listed below. Points accumulate only for the specific horse and the specific rider working together. Each team may compete in all 7 classes. Only the team's top 4 scores will be counted using a 10 point scale. Youth Trail Obstacle is an option but is not required.

In order to be considered for the award, all exhibitors MUST complete 4 out of 7 classes independently. If they require assistance during the judging phase of a class, they will not be dismissed from the class, and may still place in the class, but will not receive points toward the Ashley Hytry Award.
