

RMHA International Show Special Awards – Tabulations

All competitors for RMHA International Show Special Awards must sign up for each special award they wish to compete for in order for the show office to track their points. (Except for the Wanda Adams Challenge Trophy.) The deadline for sign up will be by the last class on Wednesday, September 4, for the adults and before the first class on Saturday, September 7, for the youth. The forms for entry are available here or at the International Show Office. For all RMHA International Special Awards, points accumulate as follows (except for the Eddie & Wanda Adams Challenge Trophy):

1 st = 10 points	6 th = 5 points
2 nd = 9 points	7 th = 4 points
3 rd = 8 points	8 th = 3 points
4 th = 7 points	9 th = 2 points
5 th = 6 points	10 th = 1 point
<u>NO</u> participation points are awarded.	

*In order for a horse/team to be considered as competing in the Trail Obstacle class, obstacles not completed on the course must be attempted 3 times (*See RMHA Rule Book-Versatility Classes – Trail Obstacle Rules for additional disqualifications and details*).

SAM TUTTLE MEMORIAL Award

The Sam Tuttle Memorial Award will be presented to the horse that achieves the highest total points in the following 7 classes **ONLY**. Points accumulate for the horse based on a 10 point scale. **The horse must * compete in and complete the Adult Trail Obstacle class** and not be disqualified. In the event of a tie, the horse with the highest score in the Adult Trail Obstacle class will be the winner.

- a. Conformation Age Division
- b. Conformation Championship
- c. Conformation Grand Championship
- d. Under Saddle Age Division (either Country Trail Pleasure, Trail Pleasure or Show Pleasure)
- e. Under Saddle Championship (either Country Trail Pleasure, Trail Pleasure or Show Pleasure) – **3y.o. Championships do not count, 4-5 y.o. Championships do not count.**
- f. Under Saddle Grand Championship (either Country Trail Pleasure, Trail Pleasure or Show Pleasure)
- g. Adult Trail Obstacle

Rea Swan Versatility Award

The Rea Swan Versatility Award will be presented to the horse that exemplifies the virtues of the Rocky Mountain Horse; versatility, exceptional gait, smoothness, and easy going disposition. Each horse may compete in all 8 categories of the following classes. **Each horse must * compete in and complete the Adult Trail Obstacle class without being disqualified.** The horse's top 5 scores (only one from each category below) will be counted using a 10-point scale. In the event of a tie, the horse with the highest score in the Adult Trail Obstacle class will be the winner. **Horses shown in the SHOW PLEASURE classes are ineligible for this award.** Championship and Grand Championships do not count toward this award. Select Amateur and AOT classes do count toward this award, Novice classes do not count.
