PLEASE NOTE: Current negative Coggins test within 1 year of show date is required and will be checked at show office. Health certificates will be required for out of state horses for travel.

This show will follow rules of the Paso Fino Horse Association for Paso Fino (PF) classes and rules of Rocky Mountain Horse Association for Rocky Mountain Horse (RM) classes. Classes for Paso Fino Horses are sanctioned by the PFHA as a local show, one show each day.

Registration copies and membership cards should be sent with entries and all owners and exhibitors must be members of PFHA. Safe Sport training must be current for any Paso Fino exhibitor who is or has been a USEF member, even though this show is not sanctioned by USEF.

Classes for Rocky Mountain Horses are point classes sanctioned by RMHA and will be judged by the current RMHA rulebook. There are 2 separate shows, an "A" show on Saturday and "B" show on Sunday. Current memberships and registrations for these horses must be presented with entries.

Open Gaited Breed (OGB) classes will be judged by rules of Friends of Sound Horses (FOSH) (www.fosh.info). These are open to any gaited breed. Exhibitors should use tack and clothing appropriate for their breed of horse. These entries do not have to present registration papers or membership cards for any association.

Entries should be sent to Andy Smith via email. The entry forms and paperwork may be scanned and sent by email to andysmithpkt@yahoo.com. Use the proper entry form provided for each breed.

Please send email entries to be received by Friday, August 8. Entries received after this time will be subject to a late penalty fee of \$15 per horse. Payment must be made by cash or check at the show.

Check in at the show office on Friday evening to get your entry packet. All owners & exhibitors (or parents of youth exhibitors) will have to sign a liability release form in order to participate. Show will start promptly at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday and 8:00 a.m. on Sunday. Breaks will be announced during the show as needed.

Entry Fees: Regular classes are \$35 per class, youth/juvenile championship classes are \$35 per class, open or amateur championships are \$45 per class. Lead line classes on Saturday are free.

DQP fees: there is a DQP fee of \$15 per horse for Saturday for Rocky Mountain Horses and for open gaited breed entries which are required by their rules to be checked by the DQP.

Stall Fees: From Friday morning through Sunday evening, horse stalls are \$85 with 2 bags of shavings included. Tack stalls are \$70 without shavings. Stalls for early arrival on Thursday or late departure on Monday are \$15 additional for each stall and each day. Extra shavings are available on site for \$9 per bag. Exhibitors may bring their own shavings (NO pelleted bedding) for their personal stalls.

Contact the show manager for stall reservations.

Grounds fee for showing out of trailer: \$15 per horse per day

Contact show manager for information about day stalls for Saturday only, if available.

RV Spaces are available at \$50 per night with electric and water hookups. All spaces include 15, 30, & 50 amp power. There is a dump station on the expo grounds. Call 336-225-0214 to reserve a space. Any exhibitor plugging a trailer to any outlet will be charged an RV fee—no exceptions!

GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION AND RULES

Awards: Rosette ribbons will be awarded in all classes, tri-color rosettes will be awarded in all championship classes. Trophies and other prizes may be awarded.

Arena Footing: Sand, sawdust, topsoil mixture, compacted to a medium standard. The competition arena is 120 x 240 ft on the floor with offset arena fence

Campers/RVs: Campers and RVs must be parked in designated areas, which are on a “first come, first serve” basis unless the utility box is marked with a reserved sign. RV spaces include electrical and water hook-ups. A sewer dump station is located on the opposite side of the arena from the RV park.

Class Calls: Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system. However, due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time.

Class Rules: *For Championship classes, you must show in and complete at least one qualifying class in a division in order to compete in the championship class in that division.

*Every rider must compete only in his/her age division except for open classes and championships if age not specified. Youth riders are 17 & under, adult riders are 18 & over.

*Any patterns to be used for equitation, trail obstacle, or other classes will be provided on show day.

*Show management reserves the right to combine, cancel, or add or split classes. Classes may be run concurrently when possible but may be judged and placed separately.

*For any other questions, show management decision will prevail and be final.

*OGB classes will follow the current FOSH rules in effect at time of the show.

*PF classes will follow the current PFHA rules in effect at time of the show.

*RM classes will follow the current RMHA rules in effect at time of the show.

***Exhibitors are responsible for making their classes on time. There will be paddock calls in the warmup arena and barns but there will be no refunds for missed classes. Please report to the show entry gate in a timely manner. Exhibitors will not be charged for scratched classes if reported to the show secretary or paddock announcer before the class starts. If tack changes are necessary, these should be reported to the paddock announcer at least 3 classes before the tack change will be needed.**

Clinic: There will be a free Q & A clinic on Friday evening after the potluck dinner, which will be conducted by some of the trainers and judges from Piedmont PFHA. Please plan to join us. Any topic can be discussed. All breed owners are welcome.

Directions: The expo center is located just off I-81 between Johnson City and Knoxville, TN, at exit 8. Take exit 8 and follow the signs to the expo center. (Go east on Hwy 25-E for approx ½ mile, then turn right onto Agricultural Park Blvd. The expo center will be on the left.)

Disposal of Medical Waste: Sharps containers are provided in convenient locations throughout the barns for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. Show management may fine any individuals, including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal.

Exhibitor Dinner: Please join us on Friday evening at 6pm for an exhibitors' potluck style dinner. Bring a dish to share if possible and join us for fellowship at the big tent beside barn A.

Hold Harmless: Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to him/her, his/her horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise. All exhibitors must sign a release form.

Host Hotel: Contact the host hotel directly to make reservations at the group rate under the show name. The hotel is located at exit 8 off I-81 near the expo center.

Safety: Unruly or unsafe horses may be excused from the show ring at the judge's discretion. Any horse, exhibitor, or spectator who causes an unsafe or threatening environment for participants may be asked to vacate the arena or show grounds. This show is for sound horses only; therefore, any horse who appears to be physically stressed or lame or injured will not be allowed to compete as per show management or judge. Entry or stall fees will not be refunded under any circumstances. Information for medical, veterinary, and farrier services will be posted on the show grounds.

Schedule: Please be prompt for your classes. The paddock announcer will call each class by number and name so pay attention to the barn calls. The schedule has been organized to minimize tack changes or rider changes in back-to-back classes. All Rocky Mountain classes are designated by "RM" in front of the class name. Paso Finos classes are designated with "PF" and Open Gaited Breed classes are "OGB."

Show Attire: Attire should be appropriate for your breed's rules and requirements under your breed association rules and should include long sleeved shirt with vest or jacket, long pants appropriate for riding, and boots with heels. All riders must wear a hat or helmet. **Helmets are strongly recommended and are required for riders ages 12 & under.** Clothing should be neat, safe, and appropriate for a family environment and should match your tack style (western attire with western tack, etc). **RM & PF classes are official point classes so attire must follow association show rules.**

Show Location: Great Smoky Mountain Expo Center, 1615 Pavilion Dr, White Pine, TN, 37890.

Not responsible for accidents, illness, loss, or damage to people, animals, equipment, or property. Concessions will be available on site during show hours. **No dogs are allowed in expo center and any dog on the grounds must be on a leash. NO ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.**

Sponsorships: Regular class sponsorships are available for \$25 per class (both days) or 5 classes for \$100. Championship class sponsorships are 3 classes for \$100. All sponsor names will be announced multiple times during their sponsored classes and throughout the show day.

Stabling: Stalls are permanent 10 ft x 10 ft with full sliding or swinging doors. Barns A has asphalt floors in all stalls. Barn B has dirt floors in all stalls. Aisles in all barns are dirt. Stalls must not be altered or damaged in any way and are subject to charge of additional fees for exhibitors for repair and replacement of parts if stalls are not left in their original condition. Stabling location for the show is at the discretion of show management. Use of stalls other than those assigned to you by show management will result in additional fees being charged

Tack: Please use appropriate tack for the breed or discipline you represent according to show rules. Any tack deemed cruel or inhumane by the judge will not be allowed. Leg wraps, splint boots, action devices, chains, and other training aids are not allowed. Bell boots or other hoof protection are allowed if allowed by breed or discipline. Training headgear is allowed if accepted under traditional rules for your class. Horses may be shown barefoot or with 4 shoes but absolutely no pads or bands. **RM and PF classes are official point classes so tack must follow association show rules. All Rockies must report to and be checked by the DQP before each class for the Saturday show.**

Vendor Spaces are available for the weekend in designated areas. Cost is \$50 per day. Vendors must supply their own tables, chairs, and displays. Please call 336-225-0214 to reserve vendor space.
